
#### JOB POSTINGS BY MONTH FOR YORK REGION

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month?












### **DEMAND BY KEY SECTOR (YORK REGION)**

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month by sector?





















### JOB POSTINGS BY JOB BOARD
